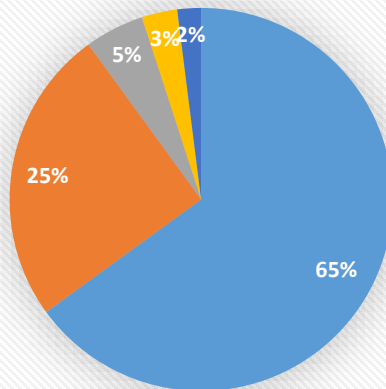


3. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes



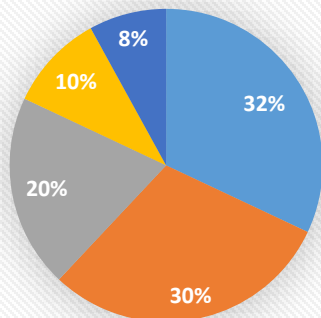

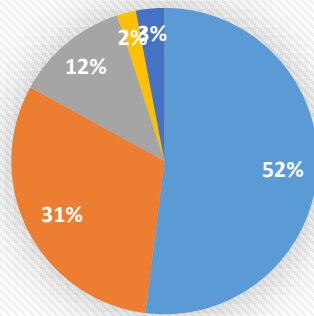

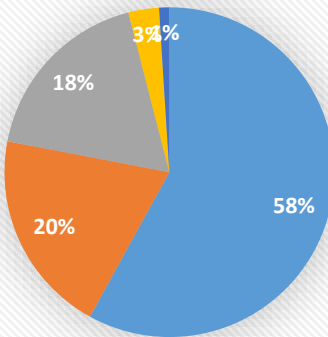

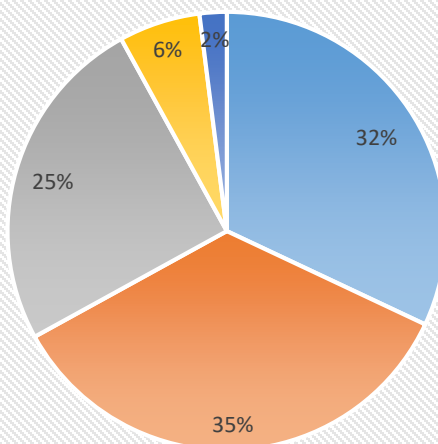

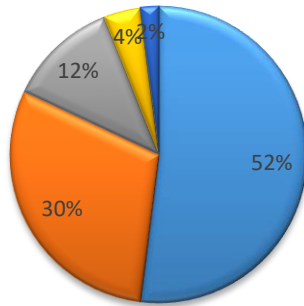

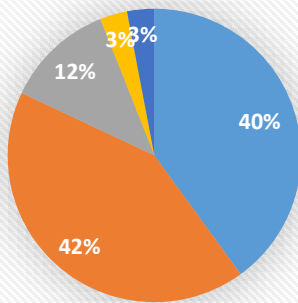

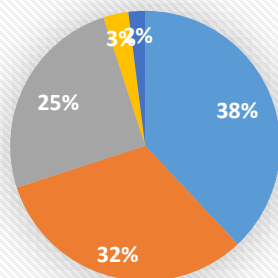

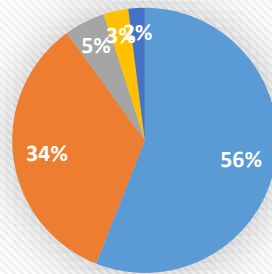

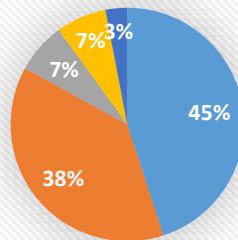
