

SUMMARY OF ICH GCP TRAINING FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Narayana Dental College & Hospital, hosted a 3 day offline "Faculty Development Program on ICH GCP training", starting from 7th to 9th of November 2022. The resource persons were Dr. Vina Vaswani, Professor, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology; Director, Centre for Ethics, Dr. Ravi Vaswani, Professor, Medicine, Additional Faculty, Centre for Ethics; Joint Secretary, YEC-1, and Dr. Uma Kulkarni, Professor, Ophthalmology, Additional Faculty, Centre for Ethics; Member-Secretary, YEC-1, Yenepoya (deemed to be University), Mangalore.

The outline of the program composed of Introduction and Pretest, Introduction to Indian Good Clinical Practice guidelines, Important definitions, Components of a protocol, Ethical and safety considerations, Vulnerability in research, Standard of care, Privacy and confidentiality in research, Informed consent process, Responsibilities of sponsor, CRO, investigators, Ethics Committee composition, functioning, Ethical review process, Ethics committee registration and accreditation, Data safety and management, Special considerations in research (Vaccine trials, Contraceptive trials, Surgical/ medical devices, Diagnostics, Herbal), NDCTR-19 rules, ICMR ethical principles, Feedback and post-test. The total duration of the training was 16 hours spread across 3 days. Most of the members of the IEC, NDCH and 2-3 faculties from each department, making the total to 32 participants had registered and attended the program. Only for 3 members of IEC, NDCH, online mode was made available via zoom meeting. It was interactive, informative, well appreciated and benefitted all.
